9:00 AM – 9:05 AM – Welcome and Opening Remarks

9:05 AM – 9:35 AM – Worship Session 1

9:35 AM – 9:50 AM – Short Exhortation 1 – The Remnants

- God doesn't need a crowd; He only needs a remnant: a small, faithful group remaining loyal to do His work on earth.

9:50 AM – 10:10 AM – Prayer Session 1 – Repentance and Consecration

- Every move of God starts with personal repentance and consecration. In this session, we repent of individual sins that might hinder the move of God in our lives and in this place. 1 John 1:9
- We ask God to cleanse our hands and purify our hearts, removing anything that hinders us from fully reflecting His character and love in all we do (Psalm 24:3-4, Matt 5:8).
- We identify with the sins of our generation: secularism, extreme individualism, relativistic morality, digital idolatry, narcissism, etc. Daniel 9:5, Nehemiah 1:6

10:10 AM – 10:30 AM – Prayer Session 2 – Personal Revival and Renewal

- Revival must start with us as individuals. Here, we ask God to begin this revival work with us, set us on fire for Him, and visit our individual prayer closets.
- We ask God to wake us from spiritual slumber and turn us away from every sin and weight that besets us. Heb 12:1
- We ask God to deliver us from a religious spirit and let the Holy Spirit refresh our hearts and minds.

10:30 AM – 11:00 AM – Prayer Session 3 – Baptism of the Holy Spirit & Holy Boldness

- We confess our need for the Holy Spirit and for the baptism and fresh filling of the Holy Spirit.
- We ask God for boldness of the Spirit, and for the Spirit of grace and prayer for this meeting. Zechariah 12:10.
- Session concludes with the ministry for the baptism of the Holy Spirit for those who desire it.

11:15 AM – 11:40 AM – Worship Session 2

11:40 AM – 11:55 AM – Short Exhortation 2 – The What and Why of Revival

- This short exhortation examines what revival is, why we need it, and why we must contend for it.

11:55 AM – 12:15 PM – Prayer Session 4 – Revival in Our Churches

- This session focuses on revival in our churches, starting with AHOW. We pray that churches in our region will become characterized by deep repentance, passionate prayer, and renewed devotion to God and His Word.
- We pray that pastors and churches in this region will reject mere religion and apathy and become incubators for a genuine move of God. Ephesians 5:14
- God will visit dead churches and release greater fire on living ones for the sake of the world. Rev.3:1-2, Psalm 85:6

12:15 PM – 12:35 PM – Prayer Session 5 – Awakening in Our Region

- When revival begins in the churches, it will spill beyond the church walls and transition into a broader spiritual awakening that impacts the surrounding culture, morality, and public life. 2 Chronicles 7:14
- Pray for an awakening in this region that leads to a greater consciousness of God, the massive salvation of souls, and a reduction in societal ills such as drug use, sexual perversion, etc.
- Pray for a stirring of spiritual hunger from city and boroughs halls to main streets and school halls. 1 Timothy 2:1-3

12:35 PM – 12:55 PM – Prayer Session 6 – Contending for Unserved Families and Friends

- This session focuses on the salvation of our families and unsaved friends. We pray that God will soften their hearts, make them receptive to the gospel, and draw our loved ones to faith in Jesus Christ. Ezekiel 36:26
- Pray against spiritual blindness: distractions, doubts, and all forces that blind individuals to the gospel. 2 Cor. 4:4
- We break the power of sin, addiction, and every stumbling block of the enemy against their salvation. Acts 26:18

12:55 PM – 1:10 PM – Short Exhortation 3 – Not on Our Watch

- This short exhortation highlights the enemy's work among young people and our responsibility to stand against them.

1:10 PM – 1:30 PM – Prayer Session 7 – Breaking the Enemy's Strongholds Over Young Adults

- Break strongholds of reliance on substances or digital distractions as coping mechanisms for pressure and pain.
- Strongholds of lies and identity disorder: believing the lie that value comes from performance, social media validation, or peer acceptance rather than from God.
- Strongholds of sexual perversion: lust, pornography, soul ties, homosexuality, etc. 2 Corinthians 10:4-5
- All other strongholds holding us and our generation captive and preventing us from living our purpose.

1:30 PM – 1:55 PM – Prayer Session 8 – Restoring What the Enemy Has Stolen from Young Adults

- Pray for the restoration of stolen spiritual, mental, and physical identity of young people. Joel 2:25
- Stolen love, and care due to poor parenting, broken marriages, absentee fatherhood etc. Zechariah 9:12
- Stole of mental health, attention span, financial future, sense of community, and hope.
- Every other thing the enemy has stolen from us and our generation.

1:55 PM – 2:10 PM – Prayer Session 9 – Activating God's Promises for Our Generation

- Pray for the activation of God's promise of strength and courage for young adults. 1 John 2:14, Proverbs 20:29
- Activation of God's promise of the outpouring of the Spirit and the gifts of the Holy Spirit upon young adults. Joel 2:28
- Activation of God's promise to teach and instruct us in His ways. Isaiah 54:13
- Activation of God's calling and His purpose upon our generation. Romans 11:29

2:10 PM – 2:30 PM – Rest and Coffee Break

2:30 PM – 2:55 PM – Worship Session 3

2:55 PM – 3:15 PM – Prayer Session 10 – Move of God in New Jersey K-12 Schools

- Pray for spiritual hunger in our schools: Ask God to spark a deep thirst for truth and a desire to seek Him among teenagers. Matthew 5:6
- Pray for courageous witness by Christian students, that they will stand out as lights rather than blend in under negative peer pressure. 2 Timothy 1:7
- Pray that Christian teachers and staff will serve as an authentic, loving Christian presence in their classrooms.

3:15 PM – 3:35 PM – Prayer Session 11 – Move of God in New Jersey Colleges and Universities

- Ask God to break apathy and spiritual blindness on every campus and release a fresh hunger for God among students and faculty. Romans 1:16
- Pray for unity and strong bonds among Christian students and groups such as InterVarsity, Cru, and local campus ministries. Pray also for wisdom, strength, and courage for professors to stand for Christ. 2 Timothy 1:7
- Pray against every antichrist ideology, policy, and system on college campuses, that the gospel will have free course on our campuses. 2 Corinthians 10:5

3:35 PM – 3:50 PM – Short Exhortation 4 – Rise Up and Take Responsibility

- A short exhortation challenging young people to rise up and take responsibility for their generation.

3:50 PM – 4:10 PM – Prayer Session 12 – Stirring Up the Gifts in This Generation

- Ask God for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit on us as young people and to spark a passionate fire for prayer and worship among the young people in this region. Joel 2:28
- Pray that the gifts and calling of God upon this generation will be activated. Pray for the immediate activation of gifts such as prophecy, healing, leadership, and wisdom. Romans 11:29, 2 Timothy 1:6
- Pray that God will give young people the courage to share their faith without shame. Romans 1:16

4:10 PM – 4:30 PM – Prayer Session 13 – Raising Kingdom Leaders & Laborers

- Pray for God to raise up bold, pure, and passionate young leaders and laborers who will transform our generation for His kingdom. 1 Timothy 4:12, Psalm 145:4
- Ask God to equip us with spiritual wisdom, remove every fear, and send us into the harvest fields with a deep love for His truth. Jeremiah 1:7
- Pray that God will raise up godly mentors, teachers, and pastors to guide young leaders among us and usher us into our purpose in the kingdom. 2 Timothy 2:2
