- 4. Develop a strong desire for the gifts of the spirit. (1 Corinthians 14:1)
- 5. Through the laying on of hands. (2 Timothy 1:6)
- 6. Being amongst like-minded people. (1 Samuel 10:10)
- 7. By assisting a man or woman of God (Exodus 24:13)

Growing your spiritual gifts:

Use the gifts to serve God's people.

1 Peter 4:10 "Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms."

The more you use the gift, the more it grows.

Luke 16:10 "Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much.

Luke 5:16 "But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed."

Subdue the flesh through fasting and prayer.

Luke 4:14 "Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news about him spread through the whole countryside."
